The ARISE international trial platform provides functions that are made possible due to its nature as a multi-country ARO network, for the implementation of clinical study projects including multi-regional trials. We support the conduct of clinical trials from concept to implementation stage - protocol design, site selection, management and reporting of trial results. To build competence and capacity to conduct high quality trials, we collaborate to develop a comprehensive capacity building for knowledge transfer and information sharing across the network.

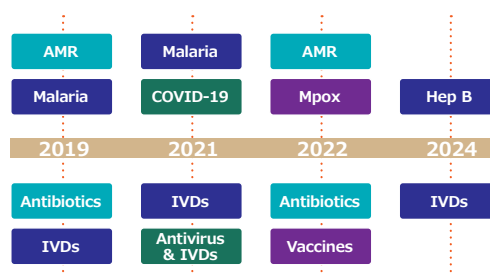

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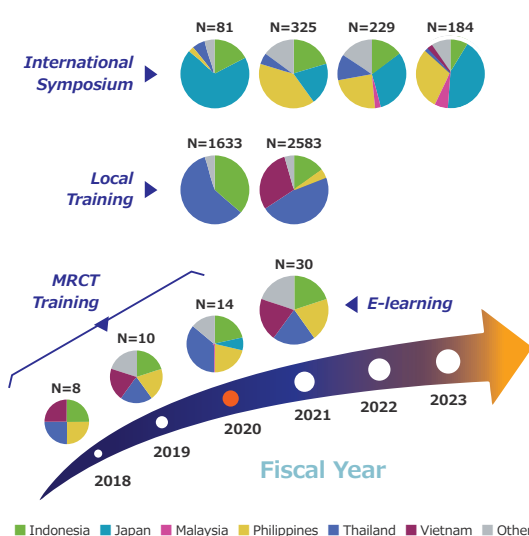
Clinical Study Projects

- We conduct international trials to tackle the global burden of infectious diseases, while proactively responding to health crises, to improve access to medical innovation in multiple regions and develop medical countermeasures (MCMs).



Comprehensive Capacity Building

- International Symposium: A hybrid clinical research/trials seminar held annually to discuss the latest updates and trends in trials conduct.
- Local Training: A training program tailored to the local needs to reduce gaps and standardize competency in trial conduct among ARISE country members.
- E-learning: An advance 3-month training course for clinical research professionals.
- MRCT Training: A short training program on Multiregional Clinical Trial (MRCT) in Japan inviting clinical research professionals from ARISE members.
